2. Main purpose of role:

To assist the Regional Manager in the operation of the trials centre and trials programme. This includes the preparation of materials for trials, equipment maintenance and reporting.

To assist with the day-to-day field trials programme of crops run from the NIABTAG Hereford centre.(HE) This involves cereals, oilseeds, pulses, potatoes, maize and other crops as necessary. Trials will be conducted at the host farm and on other locations mainly in the Herefordshire area. Work includes the establishment, management, recording and harvest of field trials to agreed protocols. Data will be handled through electronic and manual means.

There is wide scope for this post to evolve, utilising the job holders strengths and providing higher responsibility.
